Bee2Bee manages hives throughout the Houston area, where each harvest reflects the flowers, trees, and native plants found within the bees' three-mile foraging range.

Nicole also serves as a cheesemonger with Houston Dairymaids, where her appreciation for artisan cheeses naturally complements her passion for local honey. She enjoys creating pairings that highlight the unique flavors of both, celebrating the idea that every harvest tells the story of a place.
